FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (FMD)

Precautionary measures

Outbreaks of the highly contagious foot-and-mouth disease (FMD) have been reported in Hungary and Slovakia, just a few kilometres from the Austrian border. The viral disease affects cloven-hoofed animals such as cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, alpacas, llamas and wild animals. FMD is a notifiable animal disease. If this disease occurs on a farm, all clovenhoofed animals must be killed by order of the authorities.

Please help us to keep our animals healthy:

Avoid any contact with our animals. Do not feed our animals under any circumstances. Do not enter the stables or the animal enclosure.
